OWNER'S RESPONSIBILITY

To maintain the lift and user safety, the responsibility of the owner is to read and follow these instructions:

- ♦ Follow all installation and operation instructions.
- Make sure installation conforms to all applicable Local, State, and Federal Codes, Rules, and Regulations; such as State and Federal OSHA Regulations and Electrical Codes.
- Carefully check the lift for correct initial function.
- ♦ Read and follow the safety instructions. Keep them readily available for machine operators.
- Make certain all operators are properly trained, know how to safely and correctly operate the unit, and are properly supervised.
- Allow unit operation only with all parts in place and operating safely.
- Carefully inspect the unit on a regular basis and perform all maintenance as required.
- Service and maintain the unit only with authorized or approved replacement parts.

BEFORE YOU BEGIN

Receiving:

The shipment should be thoroughly inspected as soon as it is received. The signed bill of lading is acknowledgement by the carrier of receipt in good condition of shipment covered by your invoice. If any of the goods called for on this bill of lading are shorted or damaged, do not accept them until the carrier makes a notation on the freight bill of the shorted or damaged goods. 1. With no vehicle loaded on the lift, raise lift all the way off the ground and rest it on the top safety lock position.



DO NOT PROCEED OR GO NEAR THE LIFT WORK AREA UNLESS VISUAL CONFIRMATION IS MADE OF ALL SAFETY LOCKS. ALL LOCKS MUST BE ENGAGED BEFORE PROCEEDING. FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THESE INSTRUCTIONS MAY RESULT IN SEVERE PERSONAL INJURY OR DEATH.

- 2. Ensure that the lift is resting on the safeties.
- 3. Disconnect the Hydraulic Power Unit on the lift from the electrical power source.



ALL WIRING MUST BE PERFORMED BY A LICENSED ELECTRICIAN.







DO NOT PERFORM ANY MAINTENANCE OR INSTALLATION OF ANY COMPONENTS WITHOUT FIRST ENSURING THAT ELECTRICAL POWER HAS BEEN DISCONNECTED AT THE SOURCE OR PANEL AND CANNOT BE RE-ENERGIZED UNTIL ALL MAINTENANCE AND/OR INSTALLATION PROCEDURES ARE COMPLETED.

- 4. The Adjustable Limit Microswitch Kit will be installed on the inside of the Powerside Runway near the ram end of the Hydraulic Cylinder.
- 5. Select location for the Limit Switch Kit on the side of the Runway adjacent to the Hydraulic Power Unit.


5. Once desired location is selected, use the Limit Switch Bracket mounting holes as guides and drill four holes in the side of the Runway. (See Fig 1.1)



- 6. Wire the microswitch prior to mounting Kit inside the Runway. Refer to the wiring diagram on page 4.
- 7. Mount the Limit Switch Kit on the <u>inside</u> of the Runway using the four M6 Bolts, Nuts and Washers. Make sure the microswitch lever is facing as shown. (See Fig 1.2)
- 8. Route the electrical cable through the hose retainers on the underside of the Powerside Runway and through the flex hose to the power unit. Refer to the wiring diagram on the following page for power unit connection.







- 9. Reconnect the Hydraulic Power Unit on the lift to the electrical power source.
- 10. Lower the lift to the nearest safety lock position <u>below</u> the maximum desired lift height. (Read and Follow all lowering precautions and instructions that came with the lift.)





11. Ensure that the lift is resting on the safeties.

12. Adjust the microswitch on the slider bar by loosening the set screw on the top of the slider block. Slide it at least 1" (25mm) past the Cylinder Guide Assembly Arm and tighten the screw.

NOTE: The microswitch itself must be behind (towards the front of the lift) the Cylinder Guide Assembly or the Kit will not function properly.

13. Test the kit by raising the lift off of the safeties and continue raising until the Cylinder Guide Assembly Arm contacts the microswitch lever and stops the system. If the system does not stop at the maximum desired height, lower the lift onto the safeties and check the position of the microswitch. It may be necessary to bend the microswitch lever to allow more contact.
